CHAPTER 5

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter explains about the conclusion and suggestion of this research. The conclusion part would provide the result of the study. Then, the suggestion shows about the leads further researchers who are attracted and interested to analyze the similar topic of research.

5.1. Conclusion

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After analyzing *The Twits* and *Danny the Champion of the World*, the writer concludes that there are children's responsibilities toward nature in these two novels. The responsibilities come from the main and supporting characters in both novels. The analysis found three points from the books. First, there are two problems regarding children's responsibility toward nature. The first problem is animal abuse. Dahl explains how animals are used, tortured, and even killed for specific human achievements. The second problem about nature is ignorant adults. Dahl also explains the disharmony of the relationship between human beings. Not only crimes against animals, humans are also disrespectful towards other human beings.

The second point is the reaction of the characters to the problems. To achieve animals' life from human selfishness, they have to survive both physically and mentally. To help animals escape from danger other animals lend their hands. To help his father in the wood, a child has to go alone in the middle of the night. To increase the amount of money humans sacrifice animals' life.

The third point is the messages about children's responsibility toward nature. With all the problems that occur in these two novels, Dahl indirectly teaches children the responsibility not to destroy nature. From these two novels, there are several responsibilities of children as the younger generation to protect nature from destruction. First, everyone is prohibited from using and utilizing animals beyond the limits of their biological and physiological capabilities that can affect the health, safety, or cause the death of the animals. Then, teach children should be aware to be wiser towards birds, next help others as an effort to be able to adapt in dealing with a problem. Children should be responsible for everything they do. As social beings, people must be able to maintain harmonious relationships with other people. The way adults humiliate others people around them teach children to be polite to others, regardless of age, position, social status, and so on. Children have to understand that when they respect others means that they pay attention or show care for others, both humans and animals.

5.2. Suggestion

Based on the result of this research, the writer expects that this research would help further researchers who want to apply the same approach or theory to different works. The writer also suggests the researchers analyze these children's literary works with other approaches or theories, for example using readers' response approach to analyze Dahl's children's novels, using a psychological approach to analyze the main characters, and using new criticism to analyze the friendship and parenthood in children's novels.
