**FAKTOR-FAKTOR YANG BERHUBUNGAN DENGAN KEMAUAN MASYARAKAT DALAM MENGIKUTI VAKSINASI COVID-19 DI KECAMATAN PANTI KABUPATEN PASAMAN**

**ABSTRAK**

**Tujuan**

Berdasarkan data Dinas Kesehatan Kabupaten Pasaman, capaian vaksinasi COVID-19 di Kecamatan Panti untuk dosis pertama dan kedua sebanyak 60,7% dan 23,8%. Hal tersebut masih dibawah target pemerintah. Studi pendahuluan yang peneliti lakukan menunjukkan 80% masyarakat menyatakan tidak mau mengikuti vaskinasi. Tujuan penelitian ini untuk mengetahui faktor yang berhubungan dengan kemauan masyarakat mengikuti vaksinasi COVID-19 di Kecamatan Panti Kabupaten Pasaman.

**Metode**

Jenis penelitian adalah kuantitatif dengan desain *cross sectional*. Populasi adalah masyarakat berusia  $\geq 20$  tahun, sebanyak 96 sampel. Variabel pada penelitian ini berupa kemauan, usia, jenis kelamin, pendidikan, pengetahuan, paparan media massa, sikap, norma subjektif dan kontrol perilaku. Pengolahan data menggunakan analisis univariat, bivariat dan multivariat.

**Hasil**

Hasil analisis univariat menunjukkan 89,6% masyarakat tidak mau mengikuti vaksinasi COVID-19. Berdasarkan analisis bivariat diperoleh variabel pendidikan, pengetahuan, sikap dan norma subjektif berhubungan dengan kemauan masyarakat mengikuti vaksinasi COVID-19. Pada penelitian ini tidak ada variabel paling dominan yang berhubungan dengan kemauan masyarakat mengikuti vaksinasi COVID-19 di Kecamatan Panti.

**Kesimpulan**

Pendidikan, pengetahuan, sikap dan norma subjektif berhubungan dengan kemauan masyarakat mengikuti vaksinasi COVID-19 di Kecamatan Panti. Dalam upaya meningkatkan kemauan masyarakat diharapkan pemerintah daerah dan pelayanan kesehatan meningkatkan koordinasi dan melibatkan tokoh masyarakat untuk memberikan edukasi terkait vaksinasi COVID-19.

**FACTORS RELATED TO THE COMMUNITY'S WILL TO FOLLOW THE COVID-19 VACCINATION IN PANTI DISTRICT PASAMAN REGENCY**

**ABSTRACT**

**Objective**

Based on data from the Pasaman Regency Health Office, the achievement of COVID-19 vaccination in Panti District for the first and second doses was 60.7% and 23.8%. This is still below the government's target. A preliminary study conducted by researchers showed that 80% of the public said they did not want to follow vascularity. The purpose of this study is to determine the factors related to the willingness of the community to take part in the COVID-19 vaccination in Panti District, Pasaman Regency.

**Method**

This type of research is quantitative with a cross sectional design. The population is 96 sample aged  $\geq 20$  years. The variables in this study are in the form of namely vaccination willingness and independent variables consisting of age, gender, education, knowledge, mass media exposure, attitudes, subjective norms and behavioral control. Data processing uses univariate, bivariate and multivariate analysis.

**Results**

The results of the univariate analysis showed that 89.6% of people did not want to take part in the COVID-19 vaccination. Based on bivariate analysis, educational variables, knowledge, attitudes and subjective norms were obtained related to people's willingness to participate in covid-19 vaccination. In this study, there were no most dominant variables related to the willingness of the community to participate in the COVID-19 vaccination in Panti District.

**Conclusion**

Education, knowledge, attitudes and subjective norms are related to the willingness of the community to participate in the COVID-19 vaccination in Panti District. In an effort to increase the will of the community, it is hoped that local governments and health services will increase coordination and involve community leaders to provide education related to COVID-19 vaccination.
