

CHAPTER 5

CONCLUSION AND RECOMMENDATION

A. Conclusion

Based on the results and discussion of the research that has been done, the researchers draw the following conclusions:

1. The Zakat Literacy Index (ILZ) in Padang City obtained a value of 71.25 which means that the Padang City community's understanding of zakat is included in the moderate category. On the dimension of basic knowledge about zakat, a score of 75.16 is included in the moderate category. while the dimension of advanced knowledge about zakat obtained a score of 64.02 which is also included in the middle/moderate category.
2. The lowest indicator lies in the knowledge variable about zakat regulation with a score of 22.00. While the highest score is the knowledge variable about the zakat distribution program, which is 94.50. Besides that, the understanding of the people in Padang tends to be lower related to variables in the advanced dimension. This illustrates that a deeper knowledge related to zakat needs to be improved by the people of Padang City.
3. The results of the Zakat Literacy Index in Padang are expected to be feedback for the Zakat Authority or Regulator in Indonesia regarding the success rate of zakat education and socialization in the community in Padang.

4. The results of the Zakat Literacy Index in Padang City are expected to be a guide for the Zakat Authority or Regulator in Indonesia in formulating policies for the management of national zakat effectively and efficiently.

B. Recommendation

Based on the results and discussion of the research that has been done, namely about "Analysis of Measurement of the Zakat Literacy Index (ILZ) in the Padang City Community", the researchers took the following suggestions:

1. For zakat management institutions or zakat stakeholders in Padang to increase socialization, education and campaigns about the importance of paying zakat in official zakat institutions. In addition, knowledge about zakat regulation, zakat objects, zakat institutions, zakat calculations, and knowledge of digital zakat payments also needs to be improved in the city of Padang considering that these variables fall into the low category. With this research, it is hoped that later the community can learn more about zakat and it is hoped that it can increase the collection and distribution of zakat itself.
2. For further researchers, it is hoped that they will be able to sharpen the analysis of zakat literacy and be able to expand survey areas such as at the sub-districts levels to accurately determine the level of zakat knowledge of the people in the region. In addition, further researchers are also expected to expand the background of respondents, so that the

results of the next Zakat Literacy Index measurement, especially in Padang can represent the diversity of the entire population in the region.
