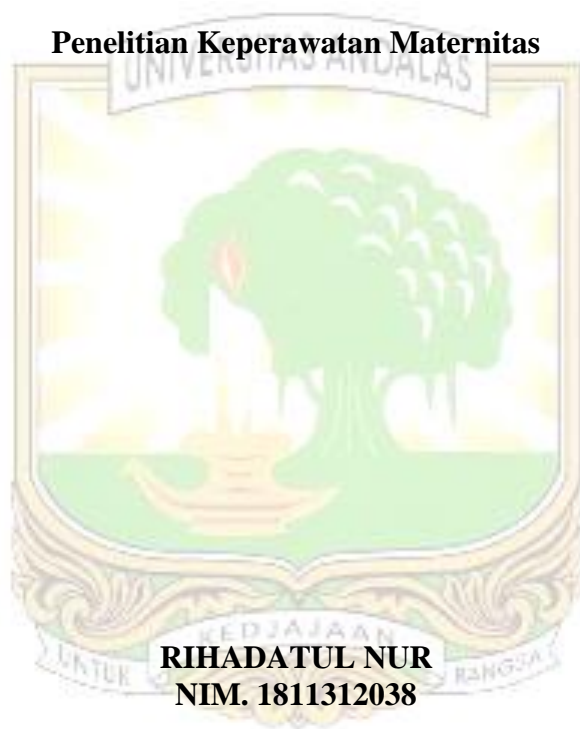

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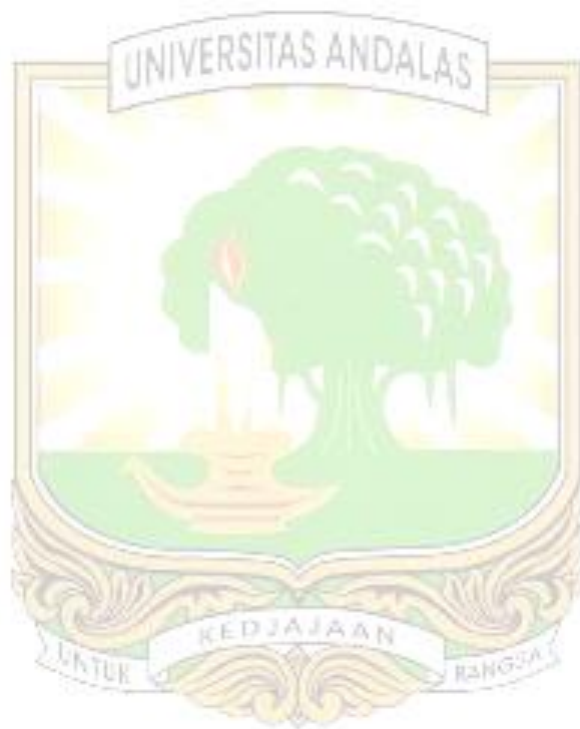

**Studi Fenomenologi: Persepsi Ibu Hamil Terkait Vaksin COVID-19
Di Wilayah Kerja Puskesmas Pauh Tahun 2022**

ABSTRAK

Vaksin COVID-19 penting bagi ibu hamil, namun masih ditemukan ibu hamil yang tidak mau melakukan vaksinasi COVID-19 di wilayah kerja Puskesmas Pauh. Meskipun sudah dianjurkan pemerintah dan himbauan petugas kesehatan. Berbagai alasan ibu hamil tidak mau vaksin, ibu hamil mengatakan takut, dan tidak yakin dengan vasin. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengeksplorasi persepsi ibu hamil terkait vaksin COVID-19 di wilayah kerja Puskesmas Pauh. Metode penelitian yang digunakan yaitu penelitian kualitatif dengan pendekatan fenomenologi dengan metode wawancara mendalam, pemilihan partisipan menggunakan *purposive sampling* dan didapatkan jumlah partisipan sebanyak 4 orang ibu hamil di wilayah kerja puskesmas pauh Kota Padang. Data dikumpulkan berupa rekaman wawancara yang dibantu dengan pedoman wawancara dan dianalisis menggunakan model Miles and Huberman. Hasil penelitian yang dilakukan dari tanggal 8-18 Juni 2022, didapatkan bahwa persepsi ibu hamil terkait vaksin COVID-19 berpersepsi negative, karena masih banyak ditemukan ibu hamil yang tidak mau melakukan vaksin karena tidak yakin terhadap vaksin tersebut. Diharapkan dengan adanya penelitian ini, dapat dijadikan masukan dan saran bagi pihak puskesmas dalam pelaksanaan program sosialisasi vaksinasi COVID-19 pada ibu hamil.

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***Phenomenological Study: Perceptions Of Pregnant Women Regarding The
COVID-19 Vaccine In The Working Area Of Pauh Health Center In 2022***

ABSTRACT

The COVID-19 vaccine is important for pregnant women, but there are still pregnant women who do not want to vaccinate against COVID-19 in the work area of the Pauh Health Center. Even though it has been recommended by the government and the advice of health workers. There are various reasons why pregnant women do not want vaccines, pregnant women say they are afraid, and are not sure about vaccines. This study aims to explore the perception of pregnant women regarding the COVID-19 vaccine in the work area of the Pauh Health Center. The research method used is qualitative research with a phenomenological approach with in-depth interviews, participant selection using purposive sampling and obtained the number of participants as many as 4 pregnant women in the work area of the Pauh Public Health Center in Padang City. Data were collected in the form of interview recordings assisted by interview guidelines and analyzed using the Miles and Huberman model. The results of research conducted from June 8-18 2022, it was found that the perception of pregnant women regarding the COVID-19 vaccine was negative, because there were still many pregnant women who did not want to do the vaccine because they were not sure about the vaccine. It is hoped that with this research, it can be used as input and advice for the puskesmas in implementing the COVID-19 vaccination socialization program for pregnant women.
