## **CHAPTER IV**

## **CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION**

## **4.1 CONCLUSION**

In this chapter, the researcher means to give a conclusion for this research. The results regarding the goal of this research will be shown in several paragraphs. Finally, this research will be concluded by referring to the two research questions that have been determined. They are the forms of Linguistic Landscape at three state universities in Padang and the differences in the linguistic landscape of language choices at three state universities in Padang.

There are 46 short notices found in three state universities in Padang. The percentage of word format usage is 5% at Andalas University, Padang State University with 42%, and Imam Bonjol Islamic State University with 83%. The percentage value of phrase format of Andalas University is 39%, Padang State University within 50% and Imam Bonjol Islamic State University within 17%. The use of the clause format in the short notice shows the results of Andalas University with as much as 28%, Padang State University with 4%, and Imam Bonjol Islamic State University with 0%. In the last format, the sentence format shows that Andalas University stands with 28%, Padang State University with 4%, and Imam Bonjol Islamic State University with 0%.

The second research question is answered with a conclusion of these comparisons. Short notices that only use English, the displayed data can be seen by comparison (Andalas University: Padang State University: Imam Bonjol Islamic State University) 78%: 27%: 50%. On the other hand, comparative data are obtained in the use of English-Indonesian with 22%: 73%: 50% (Andalas University: Padang State University: Imam Bonjol Islamic State University)

The location of short notices can be found on doors, windows, walls, parking areas, yards, stairs, and on the roadside of the university. Short notices can be found in the form of paper, signposts, banners, and plastic containing information with several words and pictures. In this analysis, the writer found that the short notices used the Indonesian language and pictures besides English words. The picture and the use of the Indonesian language will help people to understand the information.

## 4.2 SUGGESTION

The author hopes that this reset is understandable and valuable. This reset certainly has some weaknesses, but the author uses easy-to-understand language.
