**FACTORS RELATED TO THE SEXUAL BEHAVIOR OF  
ADOLESCENTS IN SMKN X CITY OF PADANG IN 2022**

**ABSTRACT**

The 2017 National Population and Family Planning Agency (BKKBN) survey based on the level of education aged 15-17 years, teenagers were in high school, men dating for the first time were 43.7% and women 42.9%. At that age, it is feared that teenagers will engage in premarital sexual behavior. The purpose of this study was to determine the factors associated with adolescent sexual behavior at SMKN X Padang City in 2022. The design of this research is cross sectional. The study was carried out from June to July 2022. The population of this study were students of SMKN X Padang City with a total sample of 124 people. Method of sampling systematic random sampling. Data collection through questionnaires. Data analysis using univariate and bivariate methods. The results of the study found that 25.8% of respondents had high-risk sexual behavior. There was a significant relationship between attitudes ( $p=0.02$ ,  $POR=2.7$ ), the role of peers ( $p=0.007$ ,  $POR=3.5$ ) and the role of peers. social media ( $p=0.000$ ,  $POR=6$ ) with adolescent sexual behavior. Attitudes, the role of peers, and the role of social media have a significant relationship Therefore, it is hoped that teenagers will be more selective in their attitude, choose friends to hang out with and not easily influenced by negative things from peers and be smarter in using social media for positive things.
