

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ABSTRACT

The logit regression shows that the independent variables are significant in the dependent variable, namely the number of family members, parents income, gender, area of residence, and parent's marital status. At the same time, the independent variable, namely head of household education, are not significant to the dependent variable, namely school dropouts. In addition, it is hoped that patture researchers can examine there analyze the things that result from the problem of the community and local government for the local papers.
