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**ANALISIS EVALUASI PROGRAM SANITASI DI PASAR BELIMBING
KOTA PADANG TAHUN 2023**

ABSTRAK

Tujuan Penelitian

Berdasarkan hasil inspeksi yang dilakukan, diketahui bahwa persentase kondisi sanitasi di Pasar Belimbing adalah 44,27% sehingga tidak memenuhi syarat kesehatan. Hal ini disebabkan karena tidak adanya koordinasi antara puskesmas dengan UPTD Pasar Belimbing sehingga tidak ada tindak lanjut terhadap permasalahan sanitasi di Pasar Belimbing. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk menganalisis program sanitasi di Pasar Belimbing Kota Padang.

Metode

Jenis penelitian ini adalah kualitatif. Dilaksanakan pada Januari sampai Juni 2023 di Pasar Belimbing Kota Padang. Pengumpulan data yaitu, wawancara mendalam, telaah dokumen, dan observasi. Informan sebanyak 9 orang menggunakan teknik *purposive sampling*. Analisis data menggunakan pendekatan analisis isi.

Hasil

Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa tidak ada permasalahan pada komponen sumber daya manusia, dana dan kebijakan. Kondisi sarana dan prasarana belum memenuhi syarat seperti belum dilakukan pengujian kualitas air bersih, SPAL yang dipenuhi sampah, belum tersedianya IPAL dan sampah yang berserakan di pasar. Pelaksanaan program sanitasi di Pasar Belimbing belum berjalan dengan optimal karena program sanitasi pasar belum terencana dengan baik, belum ada pembagian tugas yang jelas kepada sanitarian dan kurangnya koordinasi antara puskesmas dengan UPTD Pasar Belimbing sehingga tidak adanya tindak lanjut terhadap permasalahan sanitasi di Pasar Belimbing sehingga setiap tahunnya permasalahan terkait sanitasi di Pasar Belimbng selalu sama.

Kesimpulan

Program sanitasi di Pasar Belimbng belum sepenuhnya optimal, hal ini dikarenakan program sanitasi pasar belum terencana dengan baik dan kurangnya koordinasi antara puskesmas dengan UPTD pasar. Disarankan kepada Puskesmas Belimbng dan UPTD pasar Belimbng untuk lebih meningkatkan koordinasi dengan mengadakan pertemuan untuk membahas keadaan sanitasi di Pasar belimbng dan tindak lanjut yang akan dilakukan.

**ANALYSIS OF THE EVALUATION OF THE SANITATION PROGRAM AT
THE BELIMBING MARKET IN PADANG CITY IN 2023**

ABSTRACT

Research purposes

The result of inspections by the Belimbung Health Center sanitarians, it is known that the percentage of sanitary conditions in the Belimbung Market is 44,27% so it doesn't meet health requirements. This is due to the lack of coordination between the puskesmas and the UPTD of the belimbung market, so there is no foll-up on sanitation problems in the belimbung market. This research aims to analyse the implementation of sanitation in the belimbung market at padang city.

Method

This type of research was qualitative. This research took place from Januari until Juni 2023 at belimbung market of padang city. Data collection includes interview, document review, and observations. The selected informans were 9 people using a purposive sampling technique. Data analysis using content analysis approach.

Results

The results of the study show that there are no problems with the components of human resources, funds and policies. The condition of the facilities and infrastructure has not met the requirements, such as the clean water quality testing has not been carried out, the SPAL is filled with garbage, the IPAL is not yet available and the garbage is scattered in the market. The implementation of the sanitation program in the Belimbung Market has not run optimally because the market sanitation program has not been planned properly, there is no clear division of tasks for sanitarians and the lack of coordination between the health center and the Belimbung Market UPTD so that there is no follow-up on sanitation problems in the Belimbung Market so that every year problems related to sanitation in the Belimbung Market are always the same.

In conclusion

The sanitation program in the Belimbung Market is not fully optimal, this is because the market sanitation program has not been well planned and there is a lack of coordination between the puskesmas and the market UPTD. It is suggested to the Belimbung Health Center and the Belimbung Market UPTD to further improve coordination by holding a meeting to discuss the sanitation situation in the Belimbung Market and follow-up actions to be taken.
