KEMISKINAN DI INDONESIA



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ABSTRAK

The research objective is to determine the impact of human capital development on poverty in Indonesia in 2010-2021. The quantitative data used is a combination of time series and cross section data for 2010-2021. This period was chosen because time series data is only available for that period. The data source was obtained from the Central Statistics Agency (BPS) of the Province of Indonesia. The research method used in this study is the static panel data model parameters. The results showed that the average length of school variable which is a measure of human capital has a negative and significant effect on the poverty rate. So if the average length of school increases it will reduce poverty in Indonesia.
