ABSTRAK

Tujuan

Hanya 5 dari 15 indikator puskesmas ramah anak di Puskesmas Air Dingin mencapai standar petunjuk teknis Pelayanan Ramah Anak di Puskesmas. Evaluasi puskesmas ramah anak belum pernah dilakukan sejak ditetapkan tahun 2019. Tujuan penelitian ini untuk mengetahui secara mendalam indikator puskesmas ramah anak di Puskesmas Air Dingin tahun 2023.

Metode

Jenis penelitian kualitatif dengan informan sebanyak 7 orang. Teknik penentuan informan *purposive sampling*. Metode pengumpulan data dengan wawancara mendalam, telaah dokumen, dan observasi. Data diolah melalui reduksi data, penyajian data, dan penarikan kesimpulan, serta dilakukan triangulasi.

Hasil

Berdasarkan hasil penelitian indikator puskesmas ramah anak di Puskesmas Air Dingin sudah mengacu kepada Petunjuk Teknis Pelayanan Ramah Anak di Puskesmas oleh KPPPA. Belum tersedia tenaga kesehatan terlatih KHA. Belum tersedia ruang tunggu/bermain bagi anak, toilet khusus anak, toilet terpisah laki-laki dan perempuan, dan pojok baca. Belum ditemukan penyimpanan ASI dan adanya pengalihfungsian ruangan ASI. Cakupan bayi mendapatkan ASI eksklusif pada bulan Mei 2023 sebesar 49.9%. Tidak ditemukan data anak disabilitas dan data korban anak pelaku KTA. Belum dilakukannya mekanisme suara anak.

Kesimpulan

Indikator puskesmas ramah anak di Puskesmas Air Dingin sudah ideal. Puskesmas Air Dingin diharapkan dapat meningkatkan capaian indikator puskesmas ramah anak setiap tahunnya dengan mengupayakan pelatihan terkait KHA kepada petugas kesehatan di puskesmas dan mengupayakan kesediaan ruangan yang dibutuhkan anak berdasarkan indikator puskesmas ramah anak.

ABSTRACT

Objective

Only 5 of the 15 child-friendly primary health care indicators at the Air Dingin Primary Health care reached the technical guideline standards for Child-Friendly Services at the Primary Health Care. Evaluation of child-friendly primary health care has never been carried out since it was established in 2019. This study aims to find out in depth the indicators of child-friendly primary health care at Air Dingin Primary Health Care in 2023.

Method

This type of qualitative research with research informants as many as 7 people. The technique of determining the informant is purposive sampling. Methods of data collection with in-depth interviews, document review, and observation. The data is processed through data reduction, data presentation, and drawing conclusions, after which triangulation is carried out.

Result

Based on the results of the research, the indicators for child-friendly health centers at Air Dingin Primary Health Care have referred to the Technical Guidelines for Child-Friendly Services at Primary Health Care by KPPPA. KHA-trained health workers are not yet available. There is no waiting/playroom for children, special toilets for children, separate toilets for men and women, and a reading corner. Breast milk storage has not been found and there has been a conversion of the function of the breast milk room. The coverage of babies getting exclusive breastfeeding in May 2023 is 49.9%. There is no data on children with disabilities and data on child victims who are perpetrators of violence against children. The mechanism for the child's voice has not been done yet.

Conclusion

The indicators for child-friendly primary health care at Air Dingin Primary Health Care are ideal. It is hoped that Air Dingin Primary Health Care can increase the achievement of child-friendly primary health care indicators every year by providing training related to the Convention on the Rights of the Child for health workers at the primary health care and seeking the availability of rooms needed by children based on child-friendly primary health care indicators.
