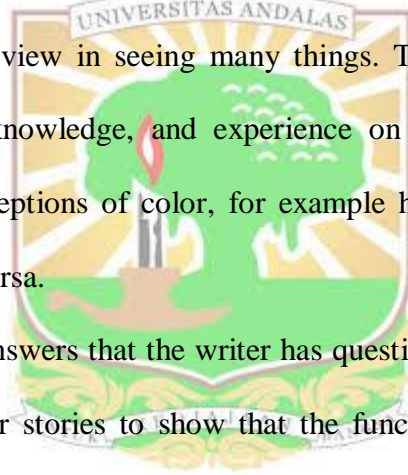


CHAPTER 4
