CHAPTER 4

CONCLUSION

This research is an analysis of Interpersonal Metafunction of Michelle Obama's final speech. The speech is held on January 6, 2017 in the White House. The data is taken from *www.time.com*. This analysis is including the analysis of Mood, Modality and Polarity by applying the methods and theories proposed by Halliday. This analysis is starting by analyze the structure of each clause which is represented by subject, finite, predicator, complement and adjunct. The subject and finite play an important role in identifying the mood of the clause.

After analyzing the data, the writer found three types of mood. They are declarative mood, interrogative mood, and imperative mood. Among three types of mood, the most dominant mood in the speech is declarative mood. The occurrence frequency of declarative clause is 268 clauses from 302 of the total clauses. In the other hand, the frequencies of interrogative and imperative clause are 12 clauses and 22 clauses from 302 of the total clauses.

Modality analysis shows that the dominant type of modality is probability with the frequency 36 clauses, followed by usuality with the frequency 7 clauses and obligation with the frequency 1 clause from the total 44 clauses.

Regarding to the analysis of mood and modality, the writer also found the two types of polarity; positive and negative polarity; with positive polarity as the dominant type in the speech. Michelle commonly uses positive clause in giving a statement rather than negative clause. The frequency of positive polarity is 288 clauses from 302 of the total clauses, followed by negative polarity with the frequency 14 clauses from 302 of the total clauses.

The analysis of mood, modality, and polarity show that in her final speech, Michelle Obama is mostly use declarative clauses because she is commonly give statements rather than questions and command. It shows that she is a polite person who treats all the same. She commonly uses a statement to appreciate the hard work of her staff shows that she is a thankful person. She emphasizes the importance of getting higher education to the young people shows that she is concerning about next generation after her administration. The analysis of modality and polarity show that Michelle Obama prefers to expresses her opinion and judgment to the audience rather than to give command and instruction rather than a question or command in her speech in a positive statement.
