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**Pengalaman Perawat dalam Implementasi

Pasien anak yang dirawat di rumah sakit bisa mengalami kondisi perburukan klinis dimana pun mereka dirawat yang berujung pada kematian jika tidak segera ditangani. Salah satu cara untuk menanggulangi hal ini adalah dengan memberikan deteksi dini perburukan klinis menggunakan instrumen *Pediatric Early Warning Score (PEWS)*. Penerapan PEWS di RSUP Dr. M. Djamil Padang masih tergolong baru yaitu sejak tahun 2018, sehingga perlu dilihat sejauh mana pengalaman perawat dalam penerapan PEWS. Tujuan penelitian adalah untuk mengeksplorasi pengalaman perawat dalam implementasi *Pediatric Early Warning Score (PEWS)* di RSUP Dr. M.Djamil Padang. Penelitian ini menggunakan metode kualitatif dengan pendekatan fenomenologi. Enam orang partisipan dipilih menggunakan teknik *purposive sampling* dengan *maximum variation sampling* dan data dikumpulkan melalui wawancara mendalam. Hasil wawancara ditranskrip secara verbatim dan dianalisis dengan menggunakan metode Collaizi. Hasil penelitian didapatkan 3 tema yaitu “pengetahuan perawat tentang PEWS sudah memadai”, “pelaksanaan PEWS belum optimal”, dan “pandangan perawat tentang PEWS”. Disarankan kepada perawat dapat lebih mengoptimalkan penerapan PEWS agar kondisi perburukan pasien dapat diketahui lebih dini dan perawat bisa segera memberikan tindakan cepat dan tepat.

ABSTRACT

Pediatric patients who are hospitalized can experience clinical deterioration wherever they are treated, which can lead to death if not treated immediately. One way to overcome this is to provide early detection of clinical deterioration using the Pediatric Early Warning Score (PEWS) instrument. Implementation of PEWS at RSUP Dr. M. Djamil Padang is still relatively new, namely since 2018, so it is necessary to see the extent of nurses' experience in implementing PEWS. The aim of the research was to explore nurses' experiences in implementing the Pediatric Early Warning Score (PEWS) at RSUP Dr. M. Djamil Padang. This research uses a qualitative method with a phenomenological approach. Six participants were selected using purposive sampling technique with maximum variation sampling and data was collected through in-depth interviews. The interview results were transcribed verbatim and analyzed using the Collaizi method. The research results showed 3 themes, namely "nurses' knowledge about PEWS is adequate", "implementation of PEWS is not optimal", and "nurses' views about PEWS". The data validity tests used are credibility, dependability and confirmability tests. It is recommended that nurses can further optimize the application of PEWS so that the patient's worsening condition can be identified early and nurses can immediately provide fast and appropriate action.
