CHAPTER 4 CONCLUSIONS & RECOMENDATION

This chapter describes the conclusion of this research. It includes conclusions and recommendations for future research related to this phenomenon.

1.1 Conclusions

Several conclusions can be drawn based on the findings and discussion in the previous chapter. The decisions obtained are related to the objectives of this research, namely, types of figures of speech and functions of figures of speech applied in The Kingdom 2007 movie. The conclusion is as follows:

1. There are ten types of figures of speech applied in The Kingdom 2007 movie, researcher found 58 figurative data applied to The Kingdom 2007 movie. The data above shows that the highest occurrence is 14 data belonging to metaphor and hyperbole. Meanwhile, paradox shows the lowest event, namely only 1 data. Metaphors are used many times in The Kingdom 2007 movie because the characters want to describe the conditions and situations with similar meanings. Meanwhile, hyperbole is used to emphasize the feelings and atmosphere that occur. The use of paradox has a low occurrence because no contradictory situations appear. Researcher did not find symbols and allegories in The Kingdom 2007 movie because symbols are figures of speech used

to express something using symbolic signs. Meanwhile, allegory is a figurative language used to reveal a hidden message by depicting it

through narrative text, so it is not found in the script for The Kingdom 2007 movie. Usually, allegory is found in storybooks.

2. The second conclusion concerns the function of the figurative language applied in The Kingdom 2007 movie. This research reveals that each type of figurative language has more than one function. They can give imaginative pleasure, give additional imagery, emotional intensity, and concrete meaning in a brief compass. To give imaginative pleasure and to give additional imagery are the highest functions applied in The Kingdom 2007 movie.

1.2 **Recommendation**

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Based on the research conclusions, several things can be suggested and recommended. Namely, for linguistics students, it is suggested that the students conduct different studies related to semantics, especially about figurative language. One of which may be dealing with elements of schemes and analysis in terms of stylistic or pragmatic fields. Second, to other researcher, semantics study is not only found in movies. It is suggested that the researcher develop this analysis with different objects, like novels, poetry, or other literary works.

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
