CHAPTER V. CONCLUSION

A. Conclusion

According to the study, it can be concluded that:

- In Padang, the long-tailed macaque distributed in seven subdistricts: Koto
 Tangah, Kuranji, Padang Utara, Padang Selatan, Bungus Teluk Kabung,
 Lubuk Kilangan, and Pauh SITAS ANDALAS
- 2. Generally, subdistricts in Padang tend to have low rather than medium and high habitat suitability for the long-tailed macaque to live
- 3. Environmental variables significantly influence the long-tailed macaque distribution are distance from road and forest cover

B. Suggestion

It is suggested that areas with high suitability for the long-tailed macaque population to get particular attention towards conflict and population management of the species due to their high potential to encounter with human through human habituation.
