ABSTRAK

Tujuan Penelitian

Tingginya kasus HIV di Puskesmas Seberang Padang menjadikannya sebagai puskesmas dengan jumlah kasus tertinggi di Kota Padang pada tahun 2024. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk menganalisis program penanggulangan HIV/AIDS di Puskesmas Seberang Padang Kota Padang Tahun 2024.

Metode

Penelitian ini merupakan penelitian kualitatif deskriptif dengan pendekatan sistem. Penelitian dilakukan Januari–Juli 2025. Informan berjumlah 9 orang yang dipilih secara purposive. Pengumpulan data dilakukan melalui wawancara mendalam, observasi, dan telaah dokumen. Analisis data dilakukan dengan tahapan reduksi data, penyajian data, dan penarikan kesimpulan. Validitas data diperoleh melalui triangulasi sumber dan metode.

Hasil

Program Penanggulangan HIV/AIDS di Puskesmas Seberang Padang telah berjalan namun belum optimal. Terdapat kendala dalam unsur input seperti kurangnya tenaga terlatih, keterbatasan dana, dan sarana yang belum memadai. Proses perencanaan, pengorganisasian, pelaksanaan, dan penilaian telah dilakukan, tetapi belum menjangkau populasi berisiko secara maksimal. Output capaian program melebihi target, namun belum berdampak pada penurunan kasus.

Kesimpulan

Pelaksanaan program penanggulangan HIV/AIDS di Puskesmas Seberang Padang belum optimal pada aspek ketersediaan tenaga, sarana prasarana, serta jangkauan pelaksanaan program. Diperlukan penguatan kapasitas tenaga, pemerataan layanan ke populasi kunci, dan peningkatan sarana pendukung agar program lebih efektif dan berkelanjutan.

ABSTRACT

Objective

The high number of HIV cases at Seberang Padang Public Health Center made it the health center with the highest case count in Padang City in 2024. This study aims to analyze the HIV/AIDS control program at Seberang Padang Public Health Center, Padang City in 2024.

Method

This study is a descriptive qualitative research using a systems approach. The research was conducted from January to July 2025. A total of 9 informants were selected using purposive sampling. Data were collected through in-depth interviews, observation, and document review. Data analysis was carried out through data reduction, data display, and conclusion drawing. Data validity was ensured through source and method triangulation.

Result

The HIV/AIDS control program at Seberang Padang Public Health Center has been implemented but remains suboptimal. Constraints were found in the input component, such as a shortage of trained personnel, limited funding, and inadequate facilities. The processes of planning, organizing, implementation, and evaluation had been conducted, yet did not fully reach key populations. The output exceeded target achievements, but had not significantly reduced case numbers.

Conclusion

The implementation of the HIV/AIDS control program at Seberang Padang Public Health Center remains suboptimal in terms of workforce availability, facilities, and program outreach. Strengthening human resource capacity, expanding services to key populations, and improving supporting infrastructure are needed to enhance program effectiveness and sustainability.
