**ABSTRAK**

**Tujuan Penelitian**

Rendahnya cakupan kunjungan balita ke posyandu (D/S) tahun 2023 yaitu 36% dari target 80%. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui faktor yang berhubungan dengan peran kader terhadap kunjungan ibu balita ke posyandu terintegrasi di wilayah kerja Puskesmas Sukamenanti tahun 2025.

**Metode**

Penelitian ini merupakan penelitian kuantitatif dengan desain *cross sectional* yang dilakukan pada Januari - Mei 2025. Populasi dalam penelitian ini adalah 80 kader posyandu di Puskesmas Sukamenanti dengan sampel sebanyak 46 kader posyandu menggunakan *proportional sampling*. Analisis data dilakukan secara univariat dengan distribusi frekuensi, bivariat dengan uji *chi-square*, dan multivariat dengan uji regresi logistik.

**Hasil**

Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa (56,5%) responden memiliki peran kader yang kurang baik. Terdapat hubungan signifikan antara pengetahuan ( $p\text{-value} = 0,003$ ), sikap ( $p\text{-value} = 0,044$ ), ketersediaan pelatihan ( $p\text{-value} = 0,015$ ), dukungan petugas kesehatan ( $p\text{-value} = 0,022$ ), dan insentif ( $p\text{-value} = 0,025$ ) dengan peran kader terhadap kunjungan ibu balita ke posyandu terintegrasi. Pengetahuan paling dominan berhubungan dengan peran kader posyandu ( $POR = 10,182$ ).

**Kesimpulan**

Kader posyandu menunjukkan peran yang masih kurang optimal dalam meningkatkan kunjungan ibu balita ke posyandu terintegrasi. Disarankan agar Puskesmas Sukamenanti dan Pemerintah Nagari melakukan peningkatan pengetahuan kader melalui edukasi berkala dan pelatihan terkait Integrasi Layanan Primer di posyandu.

**ABSTRACT**

**Objective**

The low coverage of toddler visits to integrated health posts (D/S) in 2023 was 36% of the 80% target. This study aims to determine the factors related to the role of cadres in relation to mothers' visits to the integrated health post (posyandu) in the working area of Sukamenanti Public Health Center in 2025.

**Method**

This study is a quantitative study with a cross-sectional design conducted from January - May 2025. The population in this study was 80 posyandu cadres at the Sukamenanti Health Center, with a sample of 46 cadres selected using proportional sampling. Data analysis was carried out using univariate with frequency distribution, bivariate analysis with chi-square test, and multivariate analysis using logistic regression tests.

**Results**

The study showed that 56.5% of respondents had a less than optimal role of cadres. There were significant relationships between knowledge ( $p$ -value = 0.003), attitude ( $p$ -value = 0.044), availability of training ( $p$ -value = 0.015), support from health workers ( $p$ -value = 0.022), and incentives ( $p$ -value = 0.025) with the role of cadres in visits by mothers of toddlers to integrated posyandu. Knowledge was the most dominant factor associated with the role of posyandu cadres (POR = 10.182).

**Conclusion**

Integrated health post (posyandu) cadres have demonstrated a suboptimal role in increasing visits by mothers of toddlers to integrated health posts. It is recommended that Sukamenanti Health Center and the Nagari Government increase cadres knowledge through regular education and training related to the integration of primary services at the posyandu.
