ABSTRAK

Tujuan Penelitian

Puskesmas Ambacang telah melaksanakan pelayanan kesehatan tradisional (yankestrad), namun dalam pemanfaatan layanannya masih rendah. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk menganalisis pelaksanaan yankestrad di wilayah kerja Puskesmas Ambacang Kota Padang.

Metode

Penelitian dilaksanakan pada Januari-Juni 2025 menggunakan metode kualitatif dengan 13 informan yang dipilih secara *purposive sampling*. Data dikumpulkan melalui wawancara mendalam, observasi, dan telaah dokumen dengan analisis interaktif. Data divalidasi dengan triangulasi sumber dan teknik.

Hasil

Pelaksanaan yankestrad masih mengalami beberapa kendala. Pada aspek *input*, belum ada dukungan kebijakan daerah, keterbatasan tenaga terlatih, minimnya alokasi dana, serta sarana dan prasarana yang belum memadai seperti tidak adanya ruangan khusus untuk pelayanan. Pada aspek *process*, pelayanan akupresur tidak terlaksana, pembinaan kelompok asuhan mandiri TOGA (Tanaman Obat Keluarga) tidak berkelanjutan, masih ada penyehat tradisional yang belum terdata. Pada aspek *output*, pelaksanaan yankestrad belum berjalan optimal dan belum mampu menjangkau masyarakat secara luas.

Kesimpulan

Program yankestrad masih belum berjalan dengan optimal. Diperlukan penguatan dari sisi kebijakan, peningkatan kapasitas tenaga, alokasi anggaran, pemenuhan sarana dan prasarana, dan penguatan kerja sama lintas sektor untuk mendorong pelaksanaan pelayanan kesehatan tradisional berjalan efektif dan berkelanjutan.

ABSTRACT

Objective

The Ambacang Public Health Center has implemented traditional health services (yankestrad), but utilization of these services remains low. This study aims to analyze the implementation of yankestrad in the working area of the Ambacang Public Health Center in Padang City.

Method

The study was conducted from Januari-June 2025 using a qualitative method with 13 informants selected through purposive sampling. Data were collected through in-depth interviews, observations, and document reviews with interactive analysis. Data were validated through source and technique triangulation.

Results

The implementation of yankestrad still faces several challenges. In terms of inputs, there is a lack of regional policy support, limited trained personnel, insufficient funding allocation, and inadequate facilities and infrastructure, such as the absence of dedicated rooms for services. In terms of process, acupressure services are not being provided, training for TOGA (Family Medicinal Plants) self-care groups is not sustainable, and there are still traditional healers who have not been registered. In terms of output, the implementation of yankestrad has not been optimal and has not been able to reach the community at large.

Conclusion

The traditional health service program is still not functioning optimally. Strengthening is needed in terms of policy, capacity building of personnel, budget allocation, fulfillment of facilities and infrastructure, and strengthening of cross-sectoral collaboration to promote the effective and sustainable implementation of traditional health care services.
