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ABSTRAK

Laporan Teknik ini menerangkan proses Pengadaan Pekerjaan Penanganan Longsor/Abrasi Ruas Jalan Bintunan - Lais KM 56925 (E-Katalog) Tahun Anggaran 2025 melalui Sistem E-Purchasing Katalog Elektronik dengan metode Mini-Kompetisi sesuai SE Direktorat Jenderal Bina Marga No. 08/SE/Db/2025. Penanganan diperlukan karena kondisi eksisting menunjukkan adanya kerusakan akibat abrasi pantai yang berpotensi mengancam stabilitas badan jalan nasional dan keselamatan pengguna. Metode deskriptif analitis digunakan dengan menggabungkan data primer berupa survei lapangan, DED, dan volume pekerjaan, serta data sekunder dari dokumen perencanaan dan regulasi pengadaan. Proses pengadaan meliputi perencanaan, penyusunan spesifikasi teknis dan HPS berbasis SIPASTI, pembuatan paket kompetisi, penawaran mini-kompetisi, evaluasi dokumen, penetapan pemenang, penerbitan SPMK, persiapan kontrak (pra penandatanganan kontrak), dan penandatanganan kontrak. Hasil mini-kompetisi menetapkan CV. Primadayantara Infransa sebagai pemenang dengan nilai kontrak Rp1.158.559.667,00 (96,55% dari pagu kompetisi). Seluruh tahapan dilaksanakan secara transparan, akuntabel, dan sesuai ketentuan. Pekerjaan ini diharapkan meningkatkan stabilitas jalan serta mendukung keselamatan dan kelancaran pelayanan jalan nasional pada ruas Bintunan - Lais.

E-Purchasing System Electronic Catalog (Mini-Competition)***

ABSTRACT

This Technical Report explains Procurement of Work Handling Avalanche/Abrasion Bintunan - Lais Road Section KM 56925 (E-Catalog) for Fiscal Year 2025, conducted through the Electronic Purchasing System (E-Purchasing) using the Electronic Catalog with the Mini-Competition method in accordance with the Directorate General of Highways Circular Letter No. 08/SE/Db/2025. The mitigation work is necessary because the existing conditions indicate damage caused by coastal abrasion, which potentially threatens the stability of the national road structure and the safety of road users. A descriptive analytical method was applied by combining primary data obtained from field surveys, Detail Engineering Design (DED), and work volume calculations, as well as secondary data from planning documents and procurement regulations. The procurement process includes planning, preparation of technical specifications and the Owner's Estimate (HPS) using SIPASTI, preparation of the competition package, mini-competition bidding, document evaluation, determination of the winning bidder, issuance of the Work Commencement Order (SPMK), contract preparation (pre-contract signing), and contract signing. The mini-competition resulted in CV. Primadayantara Infranusa being selected as the winner with a contract value of Rp. 1,158,559,667.00 (96.55% of the competition ceiling). All stages were carried out transparently, accountably, and in accordance with applicable regulations. The implementation of this work is expected to improve road stability and support safety and smooth national road services on the Bintunan - Lais section.
