Penelitian berikutnya juga dapat mengkaji hubungan antara CTI-CFF dengan agenda *blue economy*, perubahan iklim, dan diplomasi maritim Indonesia secara lebih luas sehingga dapat memberikan kontribusi yang lebih mendalam terhadap pengembangan kajian Hubungan Internasional, khususnya dalam bidang *regional environmental governance* dan *marine governance*.

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
