

CHAPTER IV

CONCLUSION

4.1 Conclusion

Quantitative analysis has been done in this research. There are about 51 respondents were involved in this research and participate in filling the questionnaires about their language attitude toward the use of English in the cafe's menu. After analyzing the data obtained from the questionnaires, it's found that the respondents showed positive attitudes toward the use of English in the cafe's menu with TCR is 76,2% on average percentage for each statement in the questionnaires.

From the data analysis, it can be concluded that the most valuable factors that affect the attitude of the 12th grade students of SMAN 9 Padang toward the use of English in the cafe's menu in Pauh is the prestige and power of the language. The prestige and power of the language factors can be seen from data questionnaires about 52,94% (27/51) respondents chose the prestige of the place as the criteria visiting a cafe. Furthermore, about 56,86% (28/51) respondents agreed that they feel comfortable sitting in the cafe that uses English in writing the name, menu, and decorations. Thus, there are about 62,74% (32/51) respondents feel more classy sitting in the cafe that uses English in writing the name, menu, and decorations. Additionally, there are 62,74% (32/51) respondents feel cool sitting in a cafe that uses English in writing the name, menu, and decorations. The last, about 74,50% (38/51) respondents feel more educated sitting in the cafe that uses English in writing the name, menu, and decorations.

4.2 Suggestions

Based on the finding and conclusion above, the writer suggests:

- 1) The data of the questionnaires indicates that there are still many respondents (12th grade students of SMAN 9 Padang) chose neutral attitude as their response toward the use of English in café's menu book. This fact shows that the respondents have no particular preference toward the statement in the questionnaires. Therefore, the writer suggests the other researchers with the same topic to be more specified in arranging the questionnaires in order to get more convincing responses.
- 2) The writer also suggests the other researchers with the same topic to include interview method in conducting the research in case to get more supporting data.
- 3) There are still many aspects which can be analyzed about language attitude. The other researchers may study the other matters of language attitude and this study may be used as early information to conduct further researches.
