Pendahuluan: Penanganan tersangka penyalahguna narkoba masih menjadi permasalahan, mulai dari penjatuan pidana sampai dengan pemberian rehabilitasi. Pemerintah menugaskan Badan Narkotika Nasional melakukan pemeriksaan tersangka dengan membentuk Tim Asesmen Terpadu yang beranggotakan tim hukum dan tim medis. Tim merumuskan rekomendasi sebagai pertimbangan hakim dalam memutus perkara. Permasalahan yang terjadi yaitu kurangnya tenaga, bimbingan teknis, sarana, pemeriksaan medis lanjutan tersangka, pedoman pelaksanaan asesmen terpadu dan hakim tidak menggunakan rekomendasi sebagai bahan pertimbangan dalam memutus perkara.

Tujuan: Mengalisis faktor-faktor yang berperan dalam Perumusan dan Penerimaan Hakim terhadap Rekomendasi Tim Asesmen Terpadu Badan Narkotika Nasional Provinsi Sumatera Barat.

Metode: Penelitian ini merupakan penelitian kualitatif dengan jenis *Case Study*. Penelitian ini menggunakan metode *Framework Analysis*. Penelitian dilakukan di Badan Narkotika Nasional Provinsi Sumatera Barat dan Pengadilan Negeri Padang bulan Mei – Oktober 2019.

Kesimpulan: Jumlah, kualifikasi, dan bimbingan teknis tim asesmen terpadu belum terpenuhi, pedoman pelaksanaan asesmen terpadu belum ada, tidak ada pemeriksaan lanjutan terhadap tersangka, monitor dan evaluasi yang belum optimal, kurangnya pemahaman hakim mengenai rekomendasi tim asesmen terpadu dan belum optimalnya sosialisasi kepada mengenai asesmen terpadu.

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Introduction: Handling of drug abuse suspects is still a problem that starts from the imposition of criminal sanctions to the provision of rehabilitation. The government assigned the National Narcotics Board to conduct an examination of suspects by forming an Integrated Assessment Team consisting of a legal team and a medical team. The team formulated recommendations as a consideration for judges in deciding cases. Issues related to this are lack of personnel, technical guidance, facilities, further medical examination of the suspect, guidelines for implementing integrated assessments and judges who do not use recommendations as consideration in deciding cases.

Objective: It is analyzing the factors that play a role in the formulation and acceptance of judges on the recommendations of the Integrated Assessment Team of the National Narcotics Board of West Sumatra Province.

Method: This research is a qualitative research that applies case study type. This research employs framework analysis method. The study was conducted at the National Narcotics Board of West Sumatra Province and the Padang District Court in May - September 2019.

Conclusion: The number, qualifications, and technical guidance of the integrated assessment team have not been met, the guidelines for implementing the integrated assessment have not been provided, there is no follow-up examination of the test, the monitoring and evaluation has not been optimal, the understanding of the judges regarding the recommendations of the integrated assessment team is lacking and the socialization of the integrated assessment has not been optimal.
