## **CHAPTER IV**

## CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter consists of a brief conclusion and suggestion of this research.

## 4.1 CONCLUSION

In the previous chapter, the morphological construction of fashion and beauty terms have been analyzed. Actually, there are 61 articles about fashion and beauty found in InStyle magazine, but the data presented here are nine articles because there are many data found in the magazine. This research used the theory by Trudgill (1983) to identify the register of fashion and beauty in InStyle magazine and the theory proposed by Ingo Plag (2003) to analyze the morphological construction of the register.

The findings show there are 59 terms related to fashion and 26 terms about beauty. Based on the findings, it can be seen that the most dominant terms found in the magazine are the terms related to fashion. The terms of fashion mostly come from clothing because the clothes change all the time, and women give more attention to clothing than bag and shoes.

The terms that found in the magazine are formed from three types of word formation process they are derivation, compounding, and acronym, but the most dominant word formation is compounding. Compounding is a combination of two words it can be (N+N), (Adj+N), (V+N), and (N+ADVB). The terms which found in the magazine mostly a combination of N+N (Noun and Noun) as much as 37,8%.

## 4.2 Suggestion

This research is only taken the data from one magazine and used theory about register by Trudgill (1983) and morphological construction by Ingo Plag (2003). Therefore, for the next

research will be used more than one magazine and found something new about register that is interesting to analyze.
