CHAPTER IV

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

4.1 CONCLUSION

The data of this research are newspaper article of sports medicine in medical news today. The sports medicine register is defined about body treatment, prevention, fitness, and injures. This research aims to analyze, classify, and discuss the register and situational characteristic newspaper writing of sports medicine. In this research, they are twelve (12) articles have been analyzed, which contain (9) articles that used the particular term of sports medicine, and there are two (3) articles which do not show the specific sports medicine register but they still with the sports medicine field in Medical News Today.

Based on the first research, the register marker, there are eighteen (18) register based on contextual and lexical such as, *Burn, Shed, Recovery, Fracture, Dislocation, Glycemic Index, Diet, BMI, Immunity, Workout, Energy, Strong, Recovery, Training, Warm-Up, Circulation, Strain, And Fit.* Further, there are and (19) register maker apprised in this article such, *calories, high-intensity interval training, injures, posterior cruciate ligament or PCL, Collateral ligament injuries, patellofemoral pain syndrome, tendinitis, bursitis, Osgood-Schlatter disease, arthritis, tendonitis, weight loss, obesity, abnormal muscle, L-carnitine, mesomorph, cardio, stretching, and diabetes.*

Based on the second research, the situational characteristics of the article are the intended participant, the relation among participant, function, communicative purpose and topic. Further, the writer found two (2) addressor as the reviewer and the writer in create for one article. Next, one (1) article contains the contact person of the addressor for asking for more information and having the relation among participant. Then, these articles have a different function; there are six (6) articles have a function as a news report and five (5) articles as editorial text. Furthermore, the writer found the communicative purposes that are frequently found are the specific purpose (5), general-purpose (4), and factually (3). At last, the topic of the article is mostly in a specific topic, and two (2) articles is a general topic.

4.2 SUGGESTION

This study is about register analysis of sport medical in Medical News Today newspapers. This a preliminary study about language variation. This, it is far from perfection. The register analysis in this article has a limited level of words based on lexical and situational context. Thus, the researcher recommendation for the next researcher can increase the analysis of register-based on sentences of situational context register. Despite the weaknesses, this study is expected to contribute to the study of register analysis in society. Besides that, it can also enrich knowledge about medical language, especially in sport medical.
