#### **CHAPTER IV**

### **CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION**

#### 4.1. Conclusion

This research is used to interpret the discourse structure that appears in Donald Trump's speeches on 'war on terror' in the three videos. Based on the structure of the discourse in Donald Trump's speech, this analysis uses Van Dijk's theory that divides the structure into macrostructure, superstructure, and microstructure. The elements are the strategy of the speech to interpret its intended meaning and convince the audience to believe in what it says about the issue.

The result of this research showed that there are six discourse elements in each speech is analyzed in this research. From the first speech, *Donald Trump's Speech Terrorism* as current the President United States by having six structures with the most effective method to make America safe again with creating enemy images through the fact that most people are unaware of it. It is the interpretation to convey that American fellow not to feel scared to live in their own country anymore as the guarantee that the United States is treated protected, and honored equally. Second, the speech entitled *Trump Vows to Eradicate Radical Islamic Terrorism* on the topic of against radical Islamic terrorism which is completely eradicated from the face of the earth. By having six structures as the interpretation of the speech, Donald Trump ensures that in control, policies in protection are applied to citizens and put America first. Lastly, the speech entitled *Donald Trump Warns Iran's 'Campaign of Terror' is Over* with the theme that makes

Americans believe that Donald Trump is a president who is responsible for citizens in protecting the country. By having six structures with the interpretation that the United States is indeed fighting against ISIS.

## 4.2. Suggestion

This study would like to provide some suggestions for future improvement. Those are:

1. For linguistics students RSITAS ANDALAS

It is very interesting to study the discourse structure. Therefore, it is suggested for students of linguistics to become familiar with discourse analysis in order to convey the true meaning of the speaker.

# 2. For other researchers

Since this research only focuses on discourse structures, it is better if further research involves the structures of discourse in other forms such as newspapers, movie transcripts, and advertisements. So, that the research can complete its analysis in other forms.
