

CHAPTER IV

CONCLUSION

In this research of Positive Politeness Strategy used by judges in commenting the participant in American's Got Talent Competition Show season 13, the writer found that there are 26 utterances containing positive politeness strategies with 10 strategies that the judges used to minimized FTA and safe the participant face. There are: Strategy 1 (*Notice, attend to H*), Strategy 2 (*Exaggerate; interest, approval, sympathy with H*), Strategy 3 (*Intensify interest to H*), Strategy 4 (*Use in group identity markers*), Strategy 5 (*Seek agreement*), Strategy 6 (*Avoid disagreement*), Strategy 9 (*Assert or presuppose S's Knowledge and concerns for H's wants*), Strategy 11 (*Be optimistic*), Strategy 12 (*Include both S and H in the activity*), and Strategy 15 (*Give gifts to H*). In addition, this research result shows that *Exaggerate* is the typical of positive politeness strategy that uttered by the judges. By this strategy, the judges tried to be friendly with the participant and also the participant is not embarrassed before he or she show their performance. Because the judges believe that embarrassed or disrespected can potentially influenced the participant's perform. To save the performer's face, the judges usually give compliment to them. In order to commenting the weakness of participant's performance, the judges used avoid disagreement strategy to protect the participant's face.

Moreover, the writer find out that social distance and power are the most influence the judges in American's got talent to choose their politeness strategy.

For future studies, there are many objects of Positive Politeness strategies of the world need to research. This research hopes to give information to anyone who interest in learning and do the deeper analysis
