This study utilizes quantitative approach with online survey technique. By employing 370 questionnaires that filled by domestic tourists, this study will deeper examine the role of perceived risk and nostalgia coping behaviour on tourists' behavioral intention. This research is one of the first that deeply investigates the importance of nostalgia coping behaviour and perceived risk of COVID-19 on behavioural intention during the pandemic crisis that become the novelty of this study.
