

**Tujuan Penelitian**

Tenaga kesehatan (nakes) yang bertugas di garda terdepan dalam menghadapi pandemi COVID-19 ini, selain harus berjibaku melayani pasien, juga mengalami tekanan yang berpengaruh pada kesehatan mentalnya. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui hubungan stigma dan dukungan sosial dengan stres pada tenaga kesehatan di RSUD Raja Ahmad Tabib Provinsi Kepulauan Riau Saat Pandemi COVID-19 Tahun 2021.

**Metode**

Jenis penelitian ini adalah *cross sectional* yang dilakukan pada April-Mei 2021 di RSUD Raja Ahmad Tabib Provinsi Kepulauan Riau. Instrumen penelitian menggunakan *Perceived Stress Scale-10*, *Social Support Rating Scale* dan kuesioner stigma yang disebarluaskan *online* via WhatsApp. Sampel penelitian ini sebanyak 62 responden. Teknik pengambilan sampel yaitu *probability sampling* dengan *Probability Proportional to Size* (PPS). Data dianalisis secara univariat dan bivariat menggunakan uji *chi square* dengan 95% CI.

**Hasil**

Tenaga kesehatan lebih banyak mengalami stres rendah (53,2%), stigma rendah (58,1%) dan dukungan sosial tinggi (56,5%). Terdapat hubungan antara stigma ( $p=0,00$ ) dan dukungan sosial ( $p=0,01$ ) dengan stres pada tenaga kesehatan di RSUD Raja Ahmad Tabib Provinsi Kepulauan Riau Saat Pandemi COVID-19 Tahun 2021.

**Kesimpulan**

Adanya hubungan stigma dan dukungan sosial dengan stres pada tenaga kesehatan di RSUD Raja Ahmad Tabib Provinsi Kepulauan Riau. Diharapkan pihak rumah sakit dapat mengoptimalkan layanan konseling bagi tenaga kesehatan apabila mengalami stres.



**ASSOCIATION BETWEEN STIGMA AND SOCIAL SUPPORT WITH STRESS AMONG HEALTH WORKERS AT RAJA AHMAD TABIB HOSPITAL RIAU ISLANDS PROVINCE DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC IN 2021**

**Objective**

Health workers who are on the front line in dealing with the COVID-19 pandemic, apart from having to work hard to serve patients, also experience pressure that affects their mental health. This study aims to determine the relationship between stigma and social support with stress among health workers at Raja Ahmad Tabib Hospital, Riau Islands Province during COVID-19 pandemic in 2021.

**Method**

This study uses a cross sectional method was conducted from April-May 2021 in Raja Ahmad Tabib Hospital Rau Islands Province. The research instrument used *Perceived Stress Scale-10*, *Social Support Rating Scale* and a stigma questionnaire distributed via WhatsApp. The research sample was 62 respondents. The sampling technique is probability sampling with the Probability Proportional to Size (PPS). Data were analyzed by univariate and bivariate using chi square test with 95% CI.

**Result**

Health workers experience more low stress (53.2%), low stigma (58.1%) and high social support (56.5%). There is a relation between stigma ( $p=0.00$ ) and social support ( $p=0.01$ ) with stress on health workers at Raja Ahmad Tabib Hospital, Riau Islands Province during COVID-19 pandemic in 2021.

**Conclusion**

There is a relation between stigma and social support with stress on health workers at the Raja Ahmad Tabib Hospital, Riau Islands Province. It is hoped that the hospital can optimize counseling services for health workers when experiencing stress.
