ABSTRAK

Anak sekolah merupakan generasi penerus bangsa yang perlu dijaga dan ditingkatkan serta dilindungi kesehatannya. Masalah kesehatan umum yang terjadi pada anak usia sekolah salah satunya adalah masalah cuci tangan pakai sabun (CTPS) pada masa pandemi. Perilaku cuci tangan pakai sabun yang tidak benar akan mengakibatkan meningkatnya kasus COVID-19. Perilaku tidak terlepas dari pengetahuan dan sikap individu dalam kebiasaan cuci tangan pakai sabun pada masa pandemi COVID-19. Tujuan Penelitian ini adalah untuk mengetahui hubungan pengetahuan dan sikap dengan perilaku kebiasaan cuci tangan pakai sabun (CTPS) pada siswa SD N 48 Kuranji di masa pandemi COVID-19. Desain penelitian ini adalah *cross sectional*. Jumlah sampel dalam penelitian adalah 114 orang dengan menggunakan teknik *cluster random sampling*. Alat pengumpulan data menggunakan Kuesioner pengetahuan, sikap dan perilaku cuci tangan pakai sabun di masa pandemi COVID-19. Hasil Penelitian menunjukkan sebanyak 95,6% responden memiliki pengetahuan yang cukup terhadap kebiasaan cuci tangan pakai sabun, 95,6 % responden memiliki sikap positif terhadap kebiasaan cuci tangan pakai sabun, dan 93,9% responden memiliki perilaku baik terdapat cuci tangan pakai sabun. Hasil uji *chi – square* didapatkan ada hubungan antara pengetahuan dengan perilaku kebiasaan cuci tangan pakai sabun ($p=0,000$) dan ada hubungan antara sikap dengan perilaku kebiasaan cuci tangan pakai sabun ($p=0,000$). Disarankan bagi siswa SD N 48 Kuranji agar tetap melakukan cuci tangan pakai sabun di masa pandemi Covid-19.

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**THE RELATIONSHIP OF KNOWLEDGE AND ATTITUDE WITH HAND
WASHING BEHAVIOR WITH SOAP (CTPS) STUDENTS OF SD N 48
KURANJI IN THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC**

ABSTRACT

School Kids are the next generation of the nation that need to be protected and improve and protect their health. One of common health problems that occurin school-age children is the problem of washing hands with soap (CTPS) in the era of the epidemic. Improper hand washing behavior with soap will lead to an increase in COVID-19 cases. Behavior can not be separated from knowledge and attitudes individuals in the habit of washing their hands with soap during times of COVID-19. The purpose of this study is to determine the relationship between knowledge and attitudes with the habit of washing hands with soap (CTPS) in SDN 48 students. Shortcomings in the future for the sake of COVID-19. The design of this study is cross sectional. The number of samples in this study is 114 people with cluster technique random sampling. Data collection tool using Questionnaire knowledge, attitude and behavior of handwashing with soap in the future for the sake of COVID-19. The results showed that 95.6% of respondents had sufficient knowledge of the habit of washing hands with soap, 95.6% respondents have a positive attitude towards the habit of washing hands with soap, and 93.9% of respondents have good behavior in washing their hands with soap. Test resultschi-square is found that there is a relationship between knowledge and behaviorthe habit of washing hands with soap ($p = 0.000$) and there is a relationship between attitude with the habit of washing hands with soap ($p = 0.000$). It is recommended for SDN 48 Kuranji a students continue to wash their hands with soap during the periodthe Covid-19 pandemic
