

CHAPTER IV

CONCLUSION, LIMITATION AND SUGGESTION

4.1 Conclusion

This research examines the impoliteness strategy adopted by detractors of Emmanuel Macron as President of France in the Al Jazeera News news commentary entitled "*Macron says Islam' in crisis,' prompting backlash from Muslims.*" The writer uses the impoliteness strategies proposed by Culpeper (1996, p.350), Culpeper's (2011, p. 203) to identify the functions of the impoliteness strategies and the context described by Leech (1983, p. 13). The function of impoliteness is used to understand the intent of using impoliteness strategies by commentators. This research found 129 data from 125 comments containing impoliteness strategies.

After doing the research, it was found that there are four impoliteness strategies used in the comments. The dominant strategy used is negative impoliteness. This impoliteness strategy becomes the most prevalent strategy because users tend to condescend and scorn or mockery Macron. Then, followed by bald on record, which detractors use to attack Macron's face clearly and directly, positive impoliteness is used to call Macron's other name and use taboo words. Sarcasm or mock politeness is used to satirize Macron's attitude and behavior. One of the strategies, withhold politeness, was not found in this study. In this case, withhold politeness was not found because the commentators wanted to show their disappointment with Macron's attitude and behavior by condescending and scorn or ridicule rather than silence.

The functions of impoliteness found in this research are affective impoliteness and entertaining impoliteness. Affective impoliteness is most dominantly used to show their emotions by blaming and provoking Macron. At the same time, detractors use entertaining impoliteness to make fun of Macron's name to make Macron angry and entertain others. The coercive impoliteness was not found because the detractors used impoliteness utterances to show their emotions by provoking, blaming Macron, and using entertainment to make Macron angry and entertain others.

4.2 Limitation and Suggestion

After conducting the analysis, there are two limitations in this study. Therefore, further researchers can identify:

First of all, in this study, the writer did not understand the data collection procedure. The writer takes the amount of data only based on his own will. Therefore, this makes the writer confused when writing the research methods section. The next researchers are suggested to further collect data according to procedures and based on theory. This step makes the next researchers not wrong in taking the amount of data to be used and makes it easier for researchers to write the research methods used. Secondly, for the data, the writer does not document the data in screenshots but enters it and includes it in a transcript. This problem is also suggested for future researchers; if the researchers use data through social media, they should not forget to document it with screenshots. This technique is beneficial not to jeopardize the originality of the data and threaten its validity.
