CHAPTER IV

CONCLUSION

In this research, the writer found code mixing in the videos of Deddy Corbuzier on his Youtube channel. He as a host in his channel. Muysken (2000) theory is used to analyze the types of code mixing. Meanwhile, the functions of code mixing used the theory of Hoffman(1991).

There are three types of code mixing based on Muysken (2000) theory. They are insertion, alternation, and congruent lexicalization. The percentage of insertion is 33% with 5 data. The second most used type is alternation 47% with 7 data. The less used type of code mixing is congruent lexicalization 20% with 3 data. In this research, alternation becomes the most dominant type of code mixing. The host tend to insert the English word into their utterance.

Then, there are ten functions of code mixing based on Hoffman's (1991) theories. They are talking about particular topic, being emphatic about something, interjection (inserting sentence fillers or sentence connectors), repetition used for clarification, expressing group identity, intention of clarifying the speech content for interlocutor, quoting somebody else, to soften or strengthen request or command, because of real lexical need, and to exclude other people when a comment is intended for only a limited audience communicate on.

The percentage of talking about particular topic is 52% with 9 data followed by expressing group identity 24% with 4 data, repetition use for clarification 12% 2 data, interjections and to soften or strengthen request or command is same 1 with same

percentage 6%. In this research, talking about particular topic becomes the most dominant functions of code mixing. Therefore, Deddy Corbuzier's probably feel free and more comfortable when talking to the viewer by his video on Youtube by using the language that is not their native language.

In conclusion, Deddy Corbuzier's tend to do code mixing in alternation type.

Then, the dominant functions of code mixing that they used are talking about particular topic. Probably, he always use to mix the language and applied in daily life. He always studied english by himself. He feels free and more comfortable using English that is not their native language.
